The specific objectives are: (i) to carry out a continuous improvement of the digital self-diagnosis tool "Chequeo Digital", and (ii) to generate evidence on the state of digital transformation of MSMEs in the region and on the impact of digital transformation on the competitiveness of MSMEs, taking advantage of the information provided by the tool, to better inform public policy efforts regarding the digital transformation of MSMEs.
