Activities will include (i) an external evaluation of the Fund's impact (ii) an overhaul of the communication strategy to ensure donor visibility, and (iii) action plans for the inclusion of key areas in the Fund's portfolio, such as gender and diversity, climate change, and other flagship initiatives, and (iv) knowledge dissemination activities.
