Project Description

According to the IADB, the objective is to strengthen the capacity of competition authorities in LAC to implement competition laws and policies and address illegal anticompetitive practices in a more efficient and collaborative manner, based on international best practices. The specific objectives are (i) to support efforts to conduct Peer Reviews of LAC countries with technical support from the OECD; (ii) to support the holding of the Latin American and Caribbean Competition Forum; (iii) to conduct reviews and proposals for the modernization of legal and regulatory frameworks, including manuals and guides; and (iv) to support the development of training for the implementation of competition laws.
