According to the IADB, the objective is to produce a Regional System for Fruit Fly Information, Capacity, and Communication, jointly developed by the plant health authorities of the seven countries, including a regional information and early alert exchange protocol, a regional certification standard for phytosanitary inspectors, and a regional preventive communication strategy, formally adopted by Plant Health Committee of the Southern Cone (COSAVE).
