## Project Description

The project's objective is to contribute to increase the competitiveness of the agricultural sector through improving the capacity of animal health, plant health and food safety and agricultural innovation services.

The five-year program's main goals are an increase of the sector productivity, increase of agricultural exports, avoided production losses and reduction of export rejections. The main beneficiaries of the program are agricultural producers in Suriname.

The operation was classified as category “B”, based on the use and transport of small quantities of hazardous materials (laboratory reagents, pesticides) and a moderate risk of natural disasters. The screening process identified no impacts to vulnerable communities or sensitive areas and no displacement of families.
