## Project Description

The general objective of this Technical Cooperation (TC) is to support the preparation and execution of the investment loan "Energy Transition and Integration Program for Suriname, SU-L1074". The specific objectives of the TC are to: (i) carry out detailed technical, economic, social and environmental studies of the infrastructure to be financed by the loan namely, a transmission line, a solar PV plant, and improvements to the distribution grid; (ii) provide technical support for the execution of the operation; and (iii) facilitate the dissemination of best practices and solutions for electricity transmission and access to basic services in the Suriname's interior regions.
