Project Description

According to the IADB, the general objective of this Technical Cooperation (TC) is to support the Ministry of Education, Science, and Culture (MOESC) in the technical and operational execution of SU-L1072. This assistance will focus on key areas identified during the project design phase, including: (i) developing a clear action plan for the rollout of the English language program including stakeholder awareness and buy-in for the implementation process; (ii) supporting the MOESC to accurately assess school's readiness to receive meaningful connectivity and devices for school management, teaching and learning; (iii) conducting preparatory work and stakeholder validation for the development of new secondary school TVET programs; and (iv) providing technical support for the school infrastructure activities.
