Its specific objectives are to: (i) increase investment and international trade by modernizing the regulatory and institutional framework for investment and trade; and (ii) strengthen incentives for investment in innovation. This is the second in a series of two consecutive loan operations that are technically linked but financed independently under the programmatic policy-based loan modality with a deferred drawdown option.
