## Project Description

The bank states that the projects at to strengthen technical capacities of the Unidad Coordinadora de Programa (UCP) of Ministerio de Vivienda, Ordenamiento Territorial y Medio Ambiente (MVOTMA), executing agency of the Program. In particular, it will provide technical assistance to the MVOTMA to accurate and timely respond to the demands of the most complex irregular settlements, ensuring the quality of the investments and the coverage of the Program, incorporating an innovative approach especially to the issue of public spaces. The objectives of the Program are: (i) legalize ownership of settlement lots (ii) provide basic public infrastructure and urban and community equipment (iii) strengthen neighborhood organizations and their capacity to resolve related issues with its habitat (iv) expand the supply of urbanizable land and low-cost housing.
