To achieve this objective, this TC will finance activities related to three main aspects: (i) incorporating climate change adaptation measures in Montevideo's urban drainage systems; (ii) reducing the vulnerability of urban areas to flooding and other threats exacerbated by climate change; and (iii) strengthening technical and institutional capacities in the planning and management of climate-resilient drainage infrastructures.
