## Project Description

Kuldipsingh Port Facility N.V, (“KPF”) the operator of a privately owned port (the “Port”) in Paramaribo, Suriname, to fund certain capital expenditures of the Port, including the expansion of the port’s jetty by 180 meters (from 220m to 400m), land development and the reimbursement to sister companies for expenditures undertaken (the “Project” or the “Operation”).KPF operates a cargo terminal and is mainly focused on export of logs, providing logistic services to support the oil & gas industry (offshore) and import of construction materials. The terminal has an open storage yard for logs and a warehouse for construction materials and products related with gold mining operations.
