Project Description

IDB Invest has proposed an investment of up to: (i) the equivalent of US\$40 million in Colombian pesos; and (ii) 20% of the Fund's total commitments. The Project consists of a capital investment in theFondo de Capital Privado Credicorp Capital Deuda Privada I (the "Fund"), a private credit fund created to provide tailored debt financing solutions for Mid-Market Enterprises ("MMEs") in Colombia.

The Fund will be managed by Credicorp Capital Colombia S.A. (the "Fund Manager"), a subsidiary of Credicorp Ltd. ("Credicorp"), the largest financial holding in Peru and a leader in the Andean region. The Fund will invest in private debt instruments (primarily direct loans, but potentially also corporate bonds, securitized bonds, or others). The Fund will have an investment period of four years and a total life of ten years.
