Project Description

The proposed transaction consists of an unsecured A/B Loan and Parallel Loans of approximately US\$150 million to Banco PAN, to be structured as follows: (i) US\$17.5 million held by IDB Invest; (ii) US\$32.5 million held by IDB; (iii) US\$25 million held by parallel lenders; and (iv) approximately US\$75 million mobilized through potential B loan participants. The purpose of the Project is to support the Bank in its efforts to increase financing provided to its microfinance portfolio: (i) low-income retirees portfolio; (ii) acquiring business which refers to the advanced payment of future receivables to microentrepreneurs; and (iii) low-income individuals for financing of new motorcycles. IDB Invest will provide technical advisory services to Banco PAN.
