## Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the proposed US\$5 million financing to the Borrower will support the construction of a state-of-the-art distribution center and the acquisition of new equipment to optimize Trinidad Tissues' operational capabilities. IDB Invest's financing will have a 10-year tenor including 24-month grace period. The expected project's impact encompasses: (i) stimulating growth and job creation; (ii) fostering social and environmental improvements to reduce carbon emissions, (iii) enhancing regional supply chain integration; (iv) improving productivity and competitiveness and expanding capacity resulting in higher operational efficiency while pursuing economies of scale.
