According to the Bank's website, IDB Invest will provide financing for an estimated amount of US\$12 million for the development of the International School for Development Justice, a project that The University of West Indies seeks to carry out, aiming to be one of the world's first postgraduate online learning schools dedicated exclusively to programs around sustainability and social justice. Under this project, students will be able to access degrees on sustainability and social justice from anywhere in the world, allowing individuals who may not have had the opportunity to attend a traditional university to pursue higher education. It will also provide programs related to UN Sustainability Goals that currently are not available in the market.
