Through this facility, IDB Invest seeks to promote the introduction of electric buses and other vehicles into the Peruvian market, which is at an early stage. It is expected that electric vehicles will gradually replace traditional diesel and gas vehicles, reducing carbon emissions. This initiative is aligned with Peru's commitment under the 2015 Paris Agreement and the 2020 Climate Ambition Summit.
