Project Description

The proposed financing toDinvertech, S.P.R de R.L. de C.V. (the "Borrower" or the "Company"), a Mexican agricultural producer, consists of a financing of up to US\$90 million (the "Financing"), composed of the following: (i) a senior secured A/B loan of up to US\$80 million, of which US\$40 million will be financed by IDB Invest and the remainder through third parties; and (ii) an uncommitted revolving loan of up to US\$10 million.

The proceeds of the Financing will be used to finance capital expenditures and working capital needs of the Company, related to an expansion of its installed capacity in Mexico, by incorporating an additional 50 hectares of highly technological greenhouses for the cultivation of mini peppers primarily for export, and climate-smart agriculture practices (the "Project").
