Project Description

The financing consists of a senior, unsecured, A/B loan of up to US\$150 million to Banco Agricola, S.A. ("Banco Agricola" or the "Bank"), with a term of up to five years, including an up to two-year grace period (the "Project"). The Project includes: (i) an A Loan of up to US\$40 million financed by IDB Invest (the "A Loan"); (ii) an A Loan of up to US\$10 million from a Blended Finance component provided by funds managed by IDB Invest (the "Blended Finance Loan"); and (iii) one or more B Loans related to the IDB Invest A Loan of approximately US\$100 million to be funded by various commercial lenders (the "IDB Invest B Loan").

The Project aims to: (i) provide long-term financing; and (ii) increase funding for Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises ("SMEs") and the Bank's green portfolio.
