### Project Description

According to the IDB Invest, the financing consists of a senior, unsecured, A/B loan of up to US\$150 million to Banco Agricola, S.A. ("Banco Agricola" or the "Bank"), with a term of up to five years, including an up to two-year grace period (the "Project"). The Project includes: (i) an A Loan of up to US\$40 million financed by IDB Invest (the "A Loan"); (ii) an A Loan of up to US\$10 million from a Blended Finance component provided by funds managed by IDB Invest (the "Blended Finance Loan"); and (iii) one or more B Loans related to the IDB Invest A Loan of approximately US\$100 million to be funded by various commercial lenders (the "IDB Invest B Loan").

The Project aims to: (i) provide long-term financing; and (ii) increase funding for Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises ("SMEs") and the Bank's green portfolio.

### Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.
