Project Description

According to the IDBI, BID Invest states its intention to become a shareholder in Caja Municipal de Ahorro y Credito Cusco (the "Caja" or "Caja Cusco"), for an amount equivalent in Peruvian soles ("PEN") of up to ~US\$20.6 million (the "Investment" or the "Project").

The Investment is expected to represent a minimum of 7.5% of the Caja's total shares. The objective of the Investment is to strengthen the Caja's capital structure ("Tier I"), which benefits the capital adequacy ratio and supports the continued sustainable growth of the Micro and Small Enterprises ("MSEs") in Peru.

Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares.
