The proposed transaction consists of a senior unsecure A/B loan, up to US\$ 150 million (the "Loan"), financed as follows: (i) a committed loan up to US\$50 million to be financed by IDB Invest, and (ii) a B loan up of approximately US\$ 100 millions to be financed by institutional investors. The loan has a tenor of up to three years, amortizable, and renewable for two additional periods. The project aims to increase Banco Supervielle available financing so that it can increase its SME's portfolio in the country. Additionally, IDB Invest is designing advisory services to support the Supervielle's sustainability strategy.
