Project Description

According to the IADB, the proposed transaction consists of a senior unsecured A/B loan, up to US\$ 150 million (the "Loan"), financed as follows: (i) a committed loan up to US\$50 million to be financed by IDB Invest, and (ii) a B loan up to approximately US\$ 100 million to be financed by institutional investors. The loan has a tenor of up to three years, amortizable, and renewable for two additional periods. The project aims to increase Banco Supervielle available financing so that it can increase its SME's portfolio in the country. Additionally, IDB Invest is designing advisory services to support the Supervielle's sustainability strategy.

Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.
