Project Description

According to the IDBI, the proposed transaction consists of the subscription of an issuance of Silver Subordinated Bonds, issued by Banco Popular S.A. ("Banco Popular" or the "Bank"), unsecured and denominated in Colombian Pesos ("COP"), for an amount equivalent in COP of up to US\$50 million in the Colombian secondary market (the "Issuance"), to be fully subscribed by IDB Invest. The Issuance will have a ten-year tenor, with bullet repayment and an option for full prepayment starting in the fifth year. The proceeds from the Issuance will be used to finance the Bank's senior citizens loan portfolio (silver economy).

Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.
