Project Description

According to the IDB Invest, the proposed transaction consists of a revolving receivables purchase facility of up to US\$50 million, through which Nokia Corporation will sell, under a non-recourse portfolio assignment scheme, credit rights arising from the delivery of digital solutions and services to corporate clients, subject to IDB Invest approvals.

Debtors will be notified of the assignment, and IDB Invest will directly receive the corresponding payments. The facility will not only provide flexible working capital to support Nokia's commercial expansion in key markets in the region, including Mexico, but will also facilitate a better value proposition in its commercial management vis-à-vis other unreliable technology suppliers.

The transaction also seeks to promote access to structured financing for technology suppliers in Latin America and the Caribbean.
