Project Description

According to the IDB Invest, the project involves financing of up to US\$15 million for AGE Capital, S.A., a Costa Rican company specializing in financial and operational leasing, with an initial committed line of US\$10 million and an uncommitted line of up to US\$5 million. The operation aims to expand access to leasing solutions for micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs), as well as independent professionals, with a primary focus on women and on predominantly rural, coastal, and extended urban areas where financial inclusion gaps are wider. The funds will enable financing in compliance with the regulations applicable to local issuance standards, promoting sustainability, productivity, and economic development in traditionally underserved communities.
