Project Description

According to the IADB, the project aims to support the decarbonization and transformation of Colombia's energy matrix through the generation of renewable energy, contributing to the country's transition toward cleaner and more sustainable sources.

The financing would cover the construction and operation of: (i) the JK1 and JK2 wind farms, with a combined installed capacity of 259 MW; (ii) their internal transmission lines and related civil works, including access roads; and (iii) a substation. The project is being developed by AES Colombia in partnership with Ecopetrol S.A. The wind farms would be connected to the Colombian Electric System via the Colectora 1 Substation, which is part of the UPME 06-2017 Colectora - Cuestecitas - La Loma project.
