## Project Description

According to the IDBI, the financing consists of a loan of up to US\$70 million (the "Project" or the "Financing") from IDB Invest to Banco Davivienda Salvadoreño, S.A. ("Davivienda" or the "Bank"), with a term of up to eight years. The Financing may be supplemented by one or more participants with an additional amount of approximately US\$50 million.

The Financing will be used to support the Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises ("SMEs") segments, SMEs led by women ("Women-Led SMEs"), and green financing in El Salvador. The Project may be accompanied by technical assistance in areas such as digitalization and innovation.
