Project Description

According to the IDBI, the Sao Borja-Santo Tome International Bridge Project aims to modernize and efficiently operate a critical Brazil-Argentina cross-border transport corridor under a 25-year binational PPP concession granted by COMAB. With total investments of approximately US\$58.4 million, the Project covers the international bridge, access roads, and the Unified Border Center (CUF), addressing deteriorated infrastructure, limited processing capacity, and operational inefficiencies. By upgrading roads, border facilities, and customs and sanitary systems, the Project seeks to improve border efficiency, service quality, and reliability, supporting gradual traffic growth and stronger regional integration within MERCOSUR.
