### Project Description

According to the IDBI, the proposed transaction consists of a long-term corporate financing for Irrevocable Trust No. F/2870 ("Fibra Nova") of up to US\$100 million. The proceeds will be used to fund capital expenditures related to the construction and operation of sustainable industrial parks in Mexico, as well as to refinance bridge loans used to initiate recent developments.

Fibra Nova is a Mexican FIBRA focused on the development and leasing of industrial and agro-industrial assets, with an emphasis on build-to-suit projects.
