Project Description

According to the IDB Invest, the proposed transaction consists of a senior loan of up to US\$40 million (not exceeding 20% of the Fund's Total Investment Commitments), comprising a committed tranche of US\$20 million and an uncommitted tranche of US\$20 million, to the Accial Credit Impact Fund ("ACIF"). ACIF focuses on providing senior, asset backed financing to technology enabled non-bank lenders and fintechs that serve Micro, Small, and Medium-Sized Enterprises ("MSMEs") and consumers in emerging markets, primarily in Latin America and Asia. At least 50% of the Fund's Total Investment Commitments will be allocated to transactions in Latin America and the Caribbean ("LAC").
