Project Description

The Transaction is a committed, unsecured, revolving senior import finance facility of up to US\$5,000,000. The facility will enable 2020 FMCG Inc. to finance equipment and material purchases from approved suppliers to support ongoing solar photovoltaic (PV) and Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) projects in Guyana and to fund current and future working capital needs of the company in the renewable energy and agriculture sectors. The financing will bridge cash flow gaps between payments to suppliers and receipts from clients.

The primary objective of this transaction is to (i) support renewable energy expansion in Guyana by providing financing for solar PV and BESS equipment, (ii) enhance agricultural productivity through modern equipment distribution, (iii) strengthen local capacity in renewable energy project implementation, and (iv) contribute to Guyana's climate objectives under the LCDS 2030.
