## Project Description

This Project consists of providing Agrofertil with (i) an up to US\$15 million short-term working capital facility to be cleaned-up and re-committed annually up to four times (i.e. total commitment of up to US\$15 million per year for a total commitment of US\$75 million in the 4 years period) with the same structure as the currently outstanding facility; and (ii) an up to US\$10 million 5-year loan with the same as the current facility, collateral structure but without clean-up.
