According to IFC website, the Project is an IFC A Loan of up to EUR 80 million and MCPP Loan of up to EUR 60 million in the Metropolitan Municipality of Antalya to finance the construction of a new approx. 18.2 km tramway line and procurement of approx. 20 tram vehicles (Phase 3-A). Phase 3-A will connect Antalya's underserved, yet populated, northern neighborhoods with the City center, providing access to the main bus station, city museum, state hospital, university, university hospital, judiciary and the sports hall. The line will also be interconnected with existing phases which link the city center to the airport.
