Project Description

According to bank documents, the Project is an LNG regasification terminal at the Port of Richards Bay and Transnet's associated pipeline infrastructure which can be re-purposed for natural gas transmission, the mobilization and preparation phases of which are being developed in partnership between IFC InfraVentures and Transnet. IFC InfraVentures is expected to contribute \$2.0 million to the Pre-Establishment Phase of project development. In the first instance IFC's InfraVentures funding will, amongst others, be used to finance an Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) scoping study. The Project aims to provide access to natural gas in the Provinces of KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng in the Republic of South Africa.
