Project Description

The proposed project consists of an equity investment of up to US\$15 million in Kaszek Ventures Fund III ("KV-III" or "the Fund"), a venture capital fund managed by Kaszek Ventures which focuses on investing in early-stage technology companies in Latin America.

People Affected By This Project

- (1) Global Expansion of Local Businesses: The Funds affiliated with Kaszek have invested in over 40 early stage companies in Latin America since 2011. These Funds have supported, mentored and grew many of their portfolio companies to become regional and global brands. In the current fund, IFC will be supporting early stage Latin American companies to grow and gain access to international capital markets.
- (2) Job Creation and Economic Growth: Based on IFC's experience, venture capital funds such as the KV-III will contribute meaningfully to job creation and economic growth.
- (3) Access to Capital: tech-enabled, asset light industry in LatAm is still nascent in the region and therefore, IFC's commitment to this asset class in the region will help support the necessary capital provision to support and grow such businesses.
