## Project Description

Farmoquimica or “the company” ( [www.fqm.com.br](http://www.fqm.com.br) ), is a Brazilian pharmaceutical company selling branded prescription drugs; with a product line that includes more than 50 branded drugs among 9 specialties. The company is fully owned by Laboratorios Roemmers S.A., Argentina's largest pharmaceutical company and #5 player in LAC.

The proposed IFC investment includes a loan for a total of up to USD 116 million; including US\$31 million from its own account and the balance from syndication. The proposed investment will be used to support the business combination between FQM and Divcom and finance the acquisition of brands commercialized by Divcom. Divcom Pharma ( [www1.divcom.com.br/divc/home/index.html](http://www1.divcom.com.br/divc/home/index.html) ) is a medium-sized manufacturer and distributor of Over the Counter (OTC) medicines in Brazil's Northeast (the “project”).
