## Project Description

The proposed project consists of an investment by IFC in CRRH's 12-year and 15-year bond issues planned for 2017 and 2018, respectively. By issuing a 12-year bond this year, followed by a proposed 15-year bond issue next year, CRRH is looking to extend the long-term funding curve in the West Africa Monetary Union ("WAEMU") and by extension, support the development of the capital markets in the region. This, in turn, is expected to facilitate the development of the housing finance market which needs long term finance to flourish.
