Wildeklawer, a leading producer of vegetables (carrots, onions, potatoes, beetroots, etc.) for both the South African market and for export, is headquartered in the Northern Cape area of South Africa, approximately 47km northwest of Kimberly. Landholdings amount to 3,758 ha. Operations are divided into three production units; Wildeklawer and Romance farms and De Bron farm (which is found 130 km southwest of Kimberly). All land is owned by entities within the Wildeklawer group of companies. The Wildeklawer Group comprises six companies incorporated in South Africa and focused on the farming, packing, and local trading of fresh vegetables and grains. The Group is a family-run business owned by the De Kock family. The founder, Mr. Louis de Kock, Senior, is currently joined by his wife, Cora de Kock and son, Louis de Kock, Junior, in managing the business.
