Project Description

Intelvision Limited (the “Company”) is a Seychelles based integrated telecommunications provider operating through 3 segments: (i) pay-TV (ii) data/internet and (iii) VoIP telephony/voice.

The IFC investment would be used to finance the Company's investment in a submarine cable, the Intelvision Submarine Cable System (the Intelvision cable or ISCS), connecting Seychelles to cable systems on the Eastern coast of Africa.



Investment Description

- International Finance Corporation (IFC)

The total project cost is estimated at US\$31.8 Million to be financed with a combination of debt and equity. The proposed IFC investment is a senior loan up to US\$10 Million and up to US\$10 million of syndicated funds.
