Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the proposed project consists of an unsecured senior loan of up to XAF3 billion ("Central African Franc") or approximately US\$4.6 million equivalent to La Régionale. The Project will provide local currency funding to support the microfinance institution ("MFI") in increasing its lending capacity to the retail segment, including Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises ("MSMEs") in Cameroon.
