Fund III is targeting a total raise of US \$110 million, with first close of \$40 million planned in Q2 2022. Fund III is successor to NXTP Ventures II, a 2018 vintage fund with \$31M in commitments, and NXTP Labs (Fund I), a 2013 vintage accelerator with \$20M in commitments.
