The investment will support CCA-Bank's international trade business and enhance acceptability by correspondent banks ("CBs") of Letter of Credits, Guarantees and other trade instruments issued by CCA-Bank, the ninth largest bank in Cameroon in terms of net loans, in favor of its CBs.
