The proceeds will be used to finance part of the Company's capital expenditure (CAPEX) plan 2023-2025, geared at improving its water supply and sewage infrastructure contributing to achieving its 100% service coverage objective, growing operational resiliency, enhancing service quality, and increasing efficiency.


