The Fund will back companies with deep tech focus with the emphasis on Advanced Systems, Biotech, Climate & Energy, Food and Agriculture, Robotics, and Deep Compute. The proposed IFC investment is a US\$25 million equity investment as part of the Engine Fund III capital raise.
