The proposed project consists of an equity investment of up to \$50 million in PI Fund V (Ontario), L.P. (or any parallel fund or feeder fund, together PIF V or the Fund), controlled by Patria Investments Limited (“Patria”), a leading investment firm in Latin America and the Caribbean (“LAC”). PIF V will make equity investments in a diversified portfolio of infrastructure assets across LAC, aiming to address infrastructure bottlenecks, gaps, and inefficiencies to serve the growing needs of the population and businesses while bolstering a wider use of international best practices in Environmental & Social (“E&S”) standards.
