# Early Warning System Ameria Climate

#### **Project Description**

According to the IFC, the proposed investment consists of an up to US\$250 million senior unsecured loan to be disbursed in US\$ or Armenian Dram (AMD) equivalent for IFC's own account to Ameriabank CJSC (Ameriabank or the Bank), one of the top 2 banks in Armenia and an existing IFC client. The loan will have a 5 to 7 years maturity, and the investment proceeds will be earmarked for financing micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) with 50 percent of proceeds to be allocated to eligible climate finance projects.

#### **Financial Intermediary**

According to the IFC, Ameriabank based in Armenia, it is ultimately controlled by Bank of Georgia Group PLC, a London-listed entity and a banking group with subsidiaries in Georgia and Armenia and an IFC client.
