Project Description

According to the IFC, the proposed investment is for up to US\$100 million (capped at 20% of total commitments), along with a co-investment envelope of US\$50 million in TPG Rise Climate Global South Initiative, L.P. (the Fund or GSI), a US\$1 billion (target) private-equity (PE) fund, part of a US\$2.5 billion initiative focusing on growth-stage climate-themed investments across emerging markets.
