Founded in 2015 in Piracicaba, in the State of Sao Paulo, Brazil, Genica delivers bioinputs to farmers that include biopesticides, biostimulants and inoculants designed to restore soil fertility, enhance nutrient efficiency and reduce reliance on chemical pesticides. Key crops served include soybean, corn, sugarcane, cotton and pasture.
