According to the bank, IFC will provide transaction advisory services to the Government of Antioquia, to structure a neutral fiber optic network with a view to tender it competitively under a PPP scheme. Ultimately, the Project would benefit a minimum estimate of 420,000 people by providing high speed connectivity coverage and wholesale access to existing and/or new operators that require adequate infrastructure to offer their services.
