IFC will focus with the project team on strategic areas such as supporting the implementation of the non-financial services strategy including capacity building programs for MSMEs for large-scale rollouts, diagnosing operational capacities for marketing individual guarantees, and supporting management and monitoring activities with partners.

These levers will improve access to finance for MSMEs leading to their inclusion and the increase of private sector investment.
